## Profile

- Debjani qualified as a Physiotherapist in 2002.
- Debjani began her physiotherapy career by completing an extensive junior rotation in Mumbai, India. She provided a high standard of physiotherapy expertise within a range of different clinical areas.
- Following a move to the UK in 2003, she built on her knowledge by working within the NHS for 11 years. As a senior physiotherapist, she managed a caseload for rehabilitation patients admitted in orthopaedic care and general medical wards using a range of delegated exercises and manual physical therapy treatments.
- She progressed to a Team Leader role within a Brain Injury and Neuro-rehabilitation Unit. She managed a multidisciplinary team of health and social care professionals including OTs, social workers, physiotherapists, speech and language therapists, behaviour therapists and psychologists.
- Within this role, she clinically led the treating of clients with spinal cord injuries, acute and chronic brain injuries, amputees and other long term disabilities in the community. This included vocational rehabilitation of clients in the community.
- Debjani then worked for nearly 10 years as a Team Leader for an NHS Paediatric Physiotherapy service. She was in charge of implementing core group and individual treatment sessions for children aged 0 to 19 with neurological, acquired brain injury, genetic, orthopaedic and surgical conditions in the community and acute settings. Her role included, liaising with parents and other health and social care professionals to ensure good service delivery. Attending CAF and TAF meetings, health and education meetings and care plan meetings to ensure person centred care was delivered.
- She then moved into the private sector and has utilised her extensive clinical skills within case management for the last 3 years. Providing proactive case management to assist injured parties with complex and

life changing injuries or employees absent from work for health reasons to return to pre-injury function and work activities. Carrying out Occupational Assessments for clients with musculoskeletal and psychological conditions and providing a return to work program (both face to face and telephonic assessments.)
