She has extensive experience working in partnership with various professionals within the health and social care field, using social prescribing to improve quality of life and outcomes for patients, including Activities of Daily Living (ADL) assessments, personal goal setting, equipment assessments, implementing and evaluating agreed

plans of care and referring into appropriate care pathways when needed.
